
SCHOOL VOLUNTARY CONTRIBUTIONS

Thank you to the many parents who have paid their voluntary contributions for 2018. As you would be aware the school provides incentives for parents to pay their voluntary contributions. This year we will hold our annual raffle for those families who have paid their fees. This will be drawn at our Assembly at the end of this Term.

While we understand the paying of these contributions is optional it has a significant impact on our total school budget. If all families made their contributions it would provide us with additional funds to spend on resources for our students. It really does make a huge difference!

As you can see from the graph below we have received 28% of our Kindergarten voluntary contributions, 25% of our Pre-Primary voluntary contributions and 18% of our Primary voluntary contributions.

40 HOUR FAMINE 2018 @ OPRS



This year the focus of World Vision's 40 Hour Famine is the refugee experience. Currently over 6.5 million people are refugees in the world today representing a humanitarian crisis on a global scale. People are being asked to 'live out of a backpack' for 40 hours on Friday 17 – Sunday 19 August.

World Vision's local representative, Mark, will run short workshops for Year 3, 4, 5 and 6 students at ORPS. Mark will lead an age appropriate discussion on refugee experiences and what would be vital to put in a backpack to survive a long journey on foot.

Students from Year 3-6 will be invited to 'live out of a backpack' on Saturday 18th August as a way of participating in this year's 40 Hour Famine and to ask family and friends for donations where possible.

NATIONALLY CONSISTENT COLLECTION OF DATA FOR SCHOOL STUDENTS WITH DISABILITY


All schools in Australia are a part of a national project about students with disability and/or learning difficulties.

We have been asked to provide data about the number and learning needs of children at our school. Information about the types of disabilities and the level of adjustment will be collected. Privacy and confidentiality is an explicit focus of the national data collection. The name of students or other identifying information is not provided to local or federal education authorities.

We believe it is important to contribute to this because it will help Governments and the Department develop better policies that acknowledge the level of resources needed in schools to meet the needs of all students in Western Australia.
