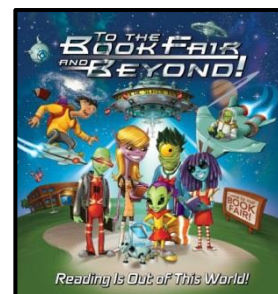

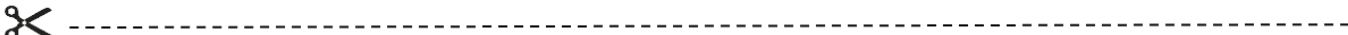


Only 2 more weeks until our very own Colour Explosion!
