Student Dress Code (Parent\Carer Guide)

Why Our Dress Code Matters

- Builds pride and belonging at school and events.
- Promotes our ORP Some reputation in the community.
- Reduces financial pressure on families.
- Enhances health and safety for all activities.

Our Uniform

Tops: Ocean Road Primary School polo shirts, dresses and jackets.

Bottoms: Dark blue shorts, skirts, or skorts.

Sports: Faction polos for Thursday/Friday sports and athletics carnivals.

Hats: Broad brimmed (minimum 5cm) all year. Reversible faction bucket hats available at the uniform shop.

Footwear

Enclosed sport shoes at all times.

On days involving water-based activities student may change into their thongs for the activity, i.e. when they get changed to go swimming.

If You Don't Have Uniform

Wear clothes as close as possible to school colours.

Allowed Accessories

Small necklaces, studs/sleepers, small scrunchies.

Not Allowed

Denim, board shorts, high heels, drop or dangle earrings make-up, tank tops, thongs/crocs (except for water-based activities).

Hair

- Long hair tied back for safety and the prevention of head lice.
- Extreme hairstyles and colours will exclude students from photos.

Expectations

Parents and staff support the dress code.

Students wear uniform daily, including for all school events.

If Dress Code Isn't Followed

- Informal teacher chat to students for one-off issues.
- Teacher to contact parents/carers for ongoing issues.
- Formal letter for repeated non-compliance.
- Students may need to change into school-provided clothing.
- Possible exclusion from excursions, photos, or events.

Exemptions

Principal may approve in the case of exceptional circumstances.
